****Police Seek Suspects Targeting Unlocked Vehicles ****

[Hopewell, VA] – During the early morning hours of April 17, 2017 a vehicle in the 3200 block of Clay St, a vehicle in the 3200 block of Saint Charles St, vehicles in the 3900 block of Gloucester and Galena Ave and a vehicle in the 800 block of Appomattox St and also a vehicle in the 400 block of Canterbury St were left unlocked and the suspects stole currency, a Cobalt Titan 45 Caliber gun and a I phone 6. Three unknown males were caught on surveillance footage being picked up by a newer model vehicle after they had gone through unlocked vehicles looking for valuables in the 3900 block of Gloucester Dr.

Captain Greg Taylor stated the “suspects were targeting unlocked vehicles that had valuables in sight, please lock your vehicles and remove valuables from your vehicle or locked in the trunk”

The Hopewell Police Department continues to investigate the recent target of unlocked vehicles.
