Update: Police Investigate Fatal Crash

[Hopewell, VA] - On Wednesday, February 24, 2021 at approximately 4:44 PM officers responded to the intersection at High Avenue and Granby Street for a reported traffic collision involving a SUV and a motorcycle. Upon arrival, responding personnel located one of the motorists with life threatening injuries. Medical personnel responded to the scene and subsequently transported the subject to the VCU Medical Center for further emergency medical treatment; however, the victim succumbed to their injuries. The Virginia State Police was notified for mutual aid assistance to perform the accident reconstruction.

The victim's identity is not being released pending notification of next of kin. The investigation of this matter continues.

Update:

The driver of the motorcycle has been identified as, Mr. Marvin Audie Rollins, age 62 of Petersburg, Virginia. He succumbed to his injuries after being transported to VCU Medical Center. "Our thoughts and prayers go out to the Rollins family," said Chief Kamran Afzal.

After completing their investigation, the Hopewell Police Department arrested the driver of the Honda Pilot, Ms. Jamia Josette Boney, age 27 of Petersburg, Virginia. Ms. Boney was charged with Involuntary Manslaughter, DUI and Driving on a suspended license 3rd or subsequent offense. Ms. Boney was transported to, and held without bond at the Riverside Regional Jail.
