****Update – Investigation of Double Homicide ****

[Hopewell, VA] – On Monday, October 18, 2021 at approximately 16:05 P. M., Mr. Maurice Mulrain of Hopewell VA was transferred into police custody after being apprehended by the U.S. Marshal Service for outstanding homicide charges. The arrest came after a lengthy in-depth investigation into the August 2020 double homicide that occurred in the 1300 block of Central Ave. The investigation is still on-going at this time. “Thanks to the family’s perseverance, our detectives’ diligence and our amazing partnership with the U.S. Marshal Service, we were able to capture this violent offender and prevent him from causing any further harm.” said Captain Damon Stoker.
