EMERGENCY MEETING OF THE ELECTORAL BOARD

NOVEMBER 18, 2018

MINUTES

(Meeting was to address the 1000-vote discrepancy between numbers on abstract and numbers on Veris arising out of a suspected mistype from Ward 4 no-votes for Question 2.)

1. Chairman Uzzle called meeting to order at 4:00 PM.
2. All three members discussed the plans to address the SBE's request to verify Ward 4's no-votes for Question 2.
 - a. Vice-Chair Mickelson and Secretary Washington agreed to meet at the Circuit Court office on Monday morning to look at the tapes from Ward 4 to see whether the no-votes were 316 or 1316.
3. Secretary Washington motioned for the Electoral Board to enter closed session pursuant to Virginia Code Section 2.2-3711 (A) (1) to discuss personnel matters concerning the office of Registrar.
 - a. The Board decided to table the motion until the next meeting.
4. Letter from Ward 1 Council Candidate Christina Luman-Bailey was reviewed and discussed.
5. Vice-Chair Mickelson discussed informed the board that the names of the previous employees of the registrar's office are still on the office voicemail.
6. Vice-Chair Mickelson and Chairman Uzzle engaged in discussion concerning the chain of command and protocol when emails are addressed to the registrar and the electoral board.
7. Secretary Washington motioned to adjourn and seconded by Vice-Chair Mickelson. Approved unanimously.
