Homicide Investigation underway in the 2700 block of Courthouse Road

[Hopewell, VA] – On July 4 2021, at approximately 8:30 P.M., officers along with Emergency Medical Services responded to Arlington Park located at 2700 courthouse Road in reference to a person in the roadway requiring medical assistance. Police received multiple calls for shots fired and a large disturbance at the park. Upon arrival, officers located an unresponsive adult male in roadway with life threatening gunshot injuries. Several vehicles at the park were damaged from gunshots as well. Emergency medical personnel were on scene and the victim was pronounced deceased.

Members of the Hopewell Police Department's Criminal Investigations Division (CID) responded to the scene and initiated an investigation of the matter. The Hopewell Police Department's Criminal Investigations Division (CID) is currently investigating this matter as a Death Investigation. The identity of the decedent is not being released pending notification of the family members. Further information and updates will be released as they become available.
