25th Annual City Point 5K and Kids Fun Run Scheduled for Saturday, October 30th

Hopewell, Virginia - The City of Hopewell Recreation and Parks Department will host the 25th annual City Point 5K and Kids Fun Run on Saturday, October 30, from 8:00am-12noon. The event is held in conjunction with the John Randolph Foundation and Tri-Cities Road Runners. The race route will take runners on a scenic tour of downtown Hopewell passing notable landmarks including the Beacon Theatre, Appomattox Manor, St. Dennis Chapel, and St. John's Episcopal Church.

The race will impact local traffic throughout the morning. Motorists should be prepared for changing traffic patterns and road closures. Randolph Road will be closed intermittently throughout the morning. Thru traffic should follow the posted detour signs. Local traffic in City Point should avoid the race route and enter/exit the neighborhood via Water Street/Ramsey Avenue/E. Broadway Avenue. If residents along the race route need to leave their homes during the race, they should wait for a gap in runners before crossing the route. All motorists are asked to exercise additional caution when traveling in the vicinity of the race route. Streets impacted will include City Point Road, Main Street, Randolph Road, Appomattox Street, Hopewell Street, Riverside Avenue, Weston Street, Canterbury Street, Francis Street, Cedar Lane, Brown Avenue, Pierce Street, Spruance Street, Burnside Street, and Cawson Street.
