## **\*\*Shooting Investigation Underway in Hopewell \*\***

**[Hopewell, VA]** – On Saturday, October 09, 2021 at approximately 3:40 A.M., officers responded to the 700 block of Davisville Ct. for a report of shots fired. As officers were canvassing the area, a single female victim at John Randolph Medical Center with a gunshot wound to her upper left arm. The injury was reported as Non-life threatening. The initial investigation revealed that the victim was driving her vehicle in the area with her child in the rear seat when someone in another vehicle shot at her multiple times. The child was not injured. The shooter's vehicle is a white SUV, unknown make or model. The victim's vehicle was struck multiple times. The motive for the shooting is unknown at this time and officers located approximately 20 plus spent casings in the area during their canvass of the scene. No other damage or injuries were reported.

Members of the Hopewell Police Department Criminal Investigation Unit have initiated an investigation into the shooting.
